Insurance Service Office (ISO) Public Protection Classification (PPC) For Travis County Emergency Service District No. 9

The Insurance Service Office (ISO) rates fire departments to determine what level of classification should be used when calculating home and business insurance premiums.

The ratings for the fire departments include communications, fire hydrant water supply, fire department personnel, station locations and equipment. The ratings are called the Public Protection Classification (PPC) and range from 1 (best) to 10 (worst). Dual ratings with letters indicate what the rating would be if there were no fire hydrants in the area.

On April 5, 2005 the Texas Department of Insurance updated our Public Protection Classification (PPC) to the following:

City of Rollingwood – PPC Class 3

City of West Lake Hills - PPC Class 3

<u>Unincorporated Areas of Travis County ESD#9</u> – <u>PPC Class 4/8B</u> (This means if there are fire hydrants in the area the rating is a Class 4 and if there are no fire hydrants present the rating is a Class 8B).

We recommend that property owners make sure their property insurance providers are aware of these ratings even though they should have reports from the Texas Department of Insurance.
