RESOLUTION NO. 2023-8 TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 9

A RESOLUTION ORDERING ELECTIONS TO BE HELD RESPECTIVELY IN TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 9 AND IN TERRITORY PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED THERETO, AND MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT AND RELATED TO SUCH ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, registered voters of the territory identified in the attached <u>Exhibit A</u> locally known as Lost Creek (the "Territory") have petitioned Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9 (the "District") to be annexed into the District pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code Section 775.051; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the District have approved the annexation and hereby find that an election should be held to determine whether to annex the Territory; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 9:

SECTION 1. An election shall be held, respectively, in Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9, and in the Territory on the 4th day of May 2024, a uniform election date in the State of Texas, which date is seventy (70) or more days from the date of the adoption of this Resolution. At each such election the following measures shall be submitted:

PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

Adding the area locally known as Lost Creek to Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9.

PROPOSITION NUMBER 2

The area locally known as Lost Creek assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9 if it is added to the district.

SECTION 2. The elections shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The precincts and locations of the election day polling places; the dates, hours and locations of the early voting places; and the names of the officers appointed to conduct the elections shall all be as determined by the Travis County Clerk pursuant to that agreement in effect on the date of this Resolution or subsequently agreed between the District and Travis County in accordance with Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code for the holding of joint elections with the various political subdivisions that share territory with the District or with the Territory and that are holding elections on the same day. A direct electronic recording voting system as the term is defined in Title 8 of the Texas Election Code, or other voting system authorized under Title 8 of the Texas Election Code and provided by Travis County pursuant to the agreement between the District and Travis County for the conduct of these elections, shall be used for early voting and for voting conducted on election day. The central counting station is established at the Travis County Elections Division, 5501 Airport Boulevard, Austin, Texas. The Board

hereby authorizes Chief David Wilson and his designee(s) to undertake those steps necessary to work with the Travis County Clerk to place these Propositions on the ballot for the May 4, 2024 Election and to ready the District for the conduct of the elections to consider the measures. These actions shall include preparation of ballots and submission of necessary filings. Ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Election Code so the voters may cast their ballots either "FOR" or "AGAINST" said measures which shall appear on the ballot in substantially the following form:

PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

Adding the area locally known as Lost Creek to Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9.

PROPOSITION NUMBER 2

The area locally known as Lost Creek assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9 if it is added to the district.

SECTION 3. Notice of this election shall be given by posting and publishing a copy of this Resolution in both Spanish and English. The posted notice shall be posted at the District's administrative offices, 1301 S. Capital of Texas Hwy, Building B, Suite 123, West Lake Hills, Tx 78746 not later than the 21st day before election day. This Resolution shall also be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory of the District not earlier than the 30th day and not later than the 10th day before election day, and in any other manner required by applicable law.
