3. Citizens' Communication – The Board of Commissioners welcomes public comments at this point on any issue, whether or not included as an item on the agenda. The Board cannot discuss or take action on matters not listed on the agenda. Anyone wishing to speak on any matter, regardless of whether included on this agenda, must sign up with the Fire Chief or his designee prior to the meeting. Speakers shall limit their comments to four (4) minutes each (*but any person providing public comment through a translator is limited to eight (8) minutes, unless the District uses simultaneous translation equipment in a manner that allows the Board to hear the translated public testimony simultaneously with the speaker*).
4. Discuss, consider, and take action to acknowledge receipt of Petition for Annexation received by the District for the defined territory described as certain lots (and as applicable, tracts) fronting on Lake Austin between Tom Miller Dam and 2940 Oestrick Lane.
5. Discuss, consider, and take action to adopt an Order Setting a Public Hearing on the Petition for Annexation and authorize issuance of notice for the same.
6. The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above as authorized by Texas Government Code, Section §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), §551.072 (Deliberations About Real Property), §551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), §551.074 (Personnel Matters), and §551.076 (Deliberation about Security Devices).
