5. Set Date and Time of future ESD No. 9 Meetings, including any special or regular meeting for the purpose of adopting a resolution approving the annexation of some or any part of the territory proposed to be annexed.

The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above as authorized by Texas Government Code, Section §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), §551.072 (Deliberations About Real Property), §551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), §551.074 (Personnel Matters), and §551.076 (Deliberation about Security Devices).

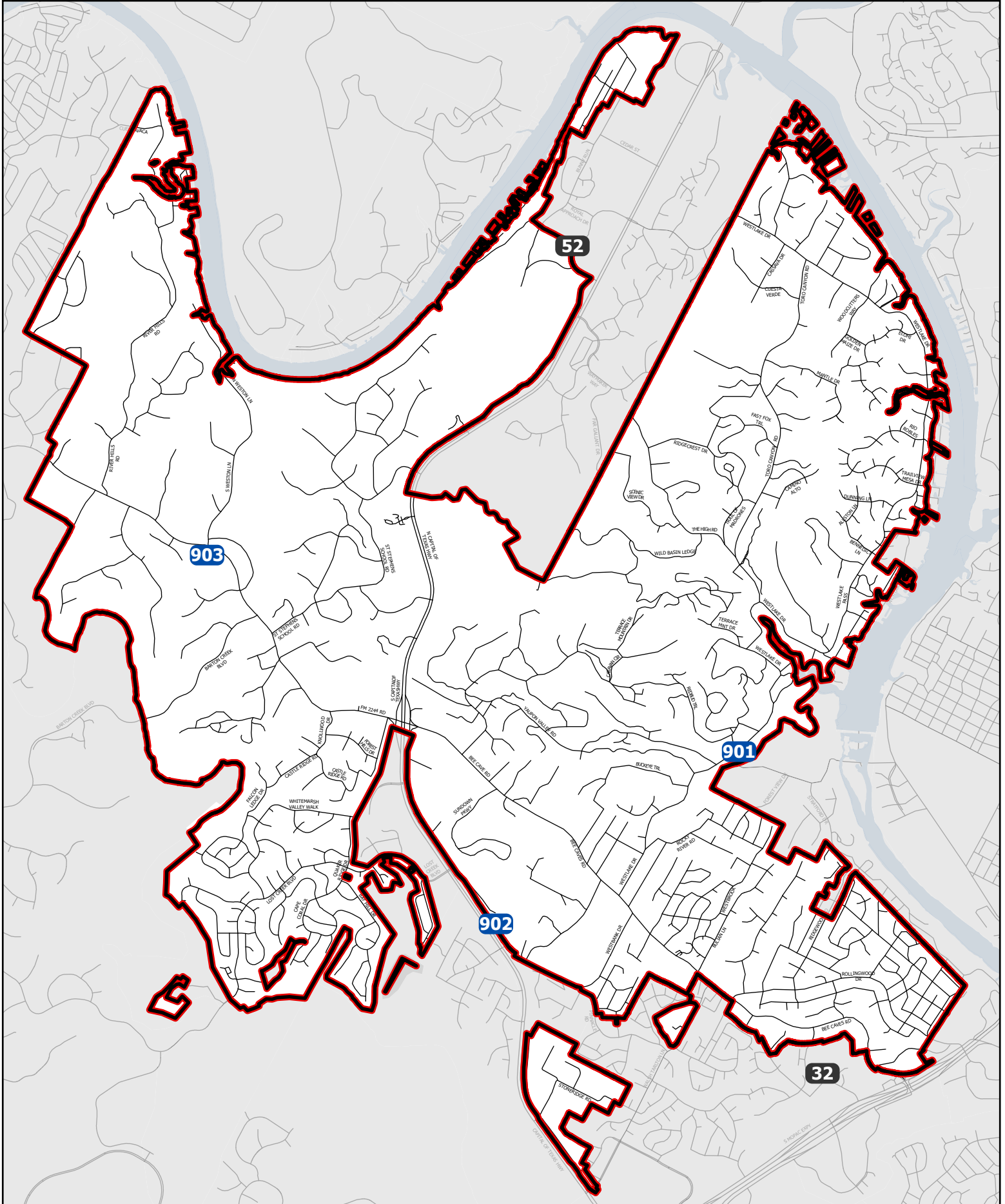

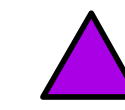

Town Hall Meeting with Citizens	March 23, 2026
Petition submitted to ESD#9	April 20, 2026
Petition for Annexation filed with District	June 16, 2026
Board adopts order and sets Public Hearing	June 16, 2026
ESD publishes in newspaper, posts notice of public hearing in territory and disannexed area	July 7, 2026
Public Hearing	July 22, 2026
Board adopts resolution for annexation	July 28, 2026
Board Issues order calling Election	July 28, 2026
Election Day	November 3, 2026
